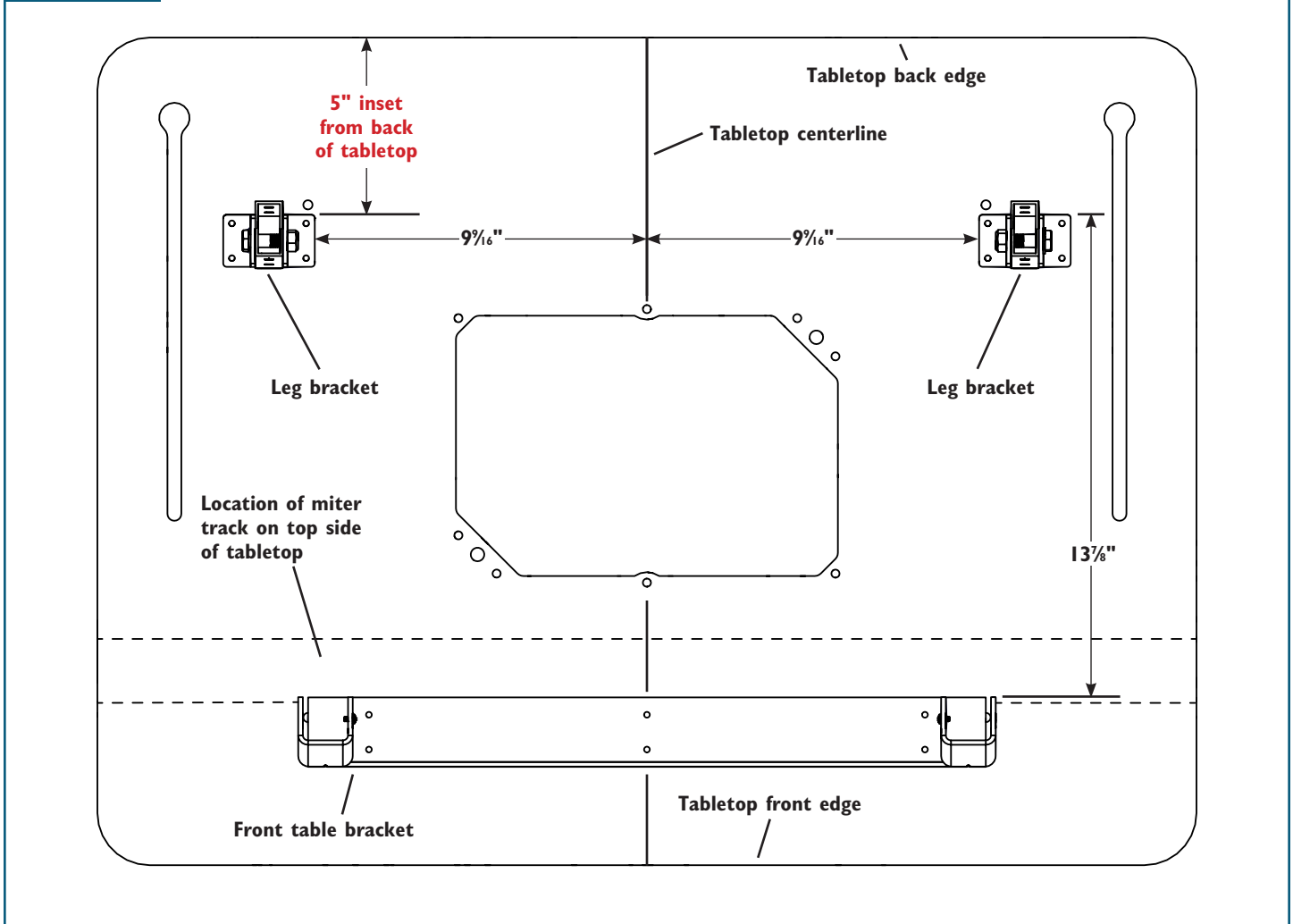


MOUNTING THE PHENOLIC ROUTER TABLETOP TO THE ROCK-STEADY FOLDING STEEL STAND

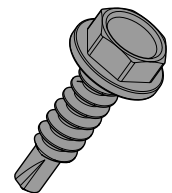
BOTTOM VIEW



What's Different for the Phenolic Table

Because the four predrilled holes for mounting the Phenolic Router Tabletop to a stand don't work for the Rock-Steady Folding Steel Stand, the mounting process requires a couple of adjustments. **The steps in the instructions should still be followed, but with these substitutions:**

- **The inset from the back of the tabletop to the leg brackets must be increased to 5".** This is necessary to position the front table bracket in front of the miter track so the mounting screws won't hit the track.
- The #8 x 3/4" mounting screws included with the Rock-Steady Stand are not strong enough for use with the Phenolic Router Tabletop. They are prone to breaking. **Instead, we are recommending the use of #8 x 5/8" self-drilling screws (see image at right) driven into 1/8" diameter pilot holes.** The Rock-Steady stand leg brackets and front table bracket should still be used to mark the locations of the pilot holes.



Recommended fasteners: #8 x 5/8" self-drilling screws in 1/8" dia. pilot holes
